
President James Young called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Trustees present were Rick Manuel, James Looft, James Young, Rick Manuell, Max Jones, Steve Brinkerhoff, and Elizabeth Hubbert. Dr. Bobbi Mattingly, Regional Superintendent of Schools and ex-officio secretary of the RBST, Assistant Regional Superintendent Kyle Thompson, Coles County State's Attorney Brian Bower, and Court Recorder Joyce Lawrence were present to help conduct the detachment hearing. Others present were Cumberland Superintendent John Hasten, Teutopolis Superintendent William Fritcher, Attorney Aaron Jones, Todd Butler, Andrew Johnson, and Michael Hubbert.

Dr. William Hill of Coles County was appointed to fill the unexpired term of James Parkes who resigned in January. Motion by Hubbert, second Looft, Roll Call Vote: 6 ayes, 0 nays. Trustees Max Jones, Steve Brinkerhoff, Elizabeth Hubbert and William Hill were administered the oath of office. The minutes from May 20, 2013 meeting were approved with a motion from Looft, second by Hubbert.


James Young, President of the Regional School Board of Trustees, had members introduce themselves then turned the meeting over to Dr. Mattingly who explained the procedure that would be followed for the Niebrugge detachment/annexation hearing. After all testimony was heard and questions were answered, Mr. Manuell moved to openly discuss the situation and proceed with a vote, Second by Dr. Hill. A roll call vote was taken. 7 ayes, 0 nays in favor of granting both parts (annexation and detachment) of the petition.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
