President James Young called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. at the Regional Office of Education. President Young led The Pledge of Allegiance. Kyle Thompson took roll call. Those present were James Young, William Hill, Max Jones, Rick Manuell, Elizabeth Hubbert, Anne Pool, Mark Wascher, Regional Superintendent Bobbi Mattingly, Assistant Regional Superintendent Kyle Thompson, and Regional Office of Education staff Marla Leasher.

Visitors included Windsor Superintendent Gavin Sronce, petitioner Mike Rincker, and court reporter for the annexation-detachment proceeding.

Elizabeth Hubbert made a motion to accept the minutes from the May 18, 2015 meeting. William Hill seconded. Motion carried. During public comment, Max Jones presented the trustees and Dr. Mattingly with comments regarding previous detachments/annexations.

Board President James Young administered the Oath of Office to newly appointed trustee Anne Pool.


The Detachment/Annexation Petition submitted to the Regional Board of School Trustees by Mike Rincker, Laurie Rincker, James Rincker and Sharon Rincker was presented. The Petition requested the detachment of certain property from Windsor CUSD #1 and annex same to Stewardson-Strasburg CUSD #5A, and to detach a certain property from Stewardson-Strasburg CUSD#5A and annex the same to Windsor Community School District #1. A complete transcript of the Hearing was recorded by Ms. Susan Keim, a Certified Reporter.

The Petitioners presented evidence in support of the prayers of their Petition.


Stewardson-Strasburg CUSD #5A supported the Petition while Windsor CUSD #1 made oral presentation in opposition of the Petition.

Upon completion of testimony and questions, the board voted to move into executive session at 7:55 p.m. The meeting resumed at 8:10 p.m. Kyle Thompson took roll call vote. The results were Manuell – no; Hill – no; Jones – no; Young – no; Pool – no, Hubbert-no and Wascher – yes. The petition was denied on a vote of 1 yes, 6 no. The transcripts from the hearing are filed at the office of the Regional Superintendent of Schools, 730 Seventh Street in Charleston.

Mark Wascher made a motion to adjourn the meeting. William Hill seconded the motion. Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 8:12 p.m.
