No public comment was made.


Dave McCabe moved to approve minutes from the March 5, 2018 meeting. Roy Clapp seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Dr. Mattingly presented the Report of Official Acts and Quarterly Funds Report. She pointed out the increase in GED testers and homeless youth identified this quarter. To qualify as a homeless student, he/she must lack a fixed, regular or adequate nighttime residence. Dr. Mattingly reported that all school buildings in our region earned an "R" rating this year. This is the highest level awarded.

Regional Superintendent Dr. Mattingly presented the FY19 budget draft. Approval will be sought at the September 10, 2018 meeting.

Asst. Regional Superintendent of Schools Dr. Kyle Thompson provided a legislative update including the possibility of a minimum teacher salary requirement. He discussed the shortage of teachers and substitute teachers both locally and statewide. Dr. Thompson also reported on the International Rotary sponsored Restorative Practice workshop held at the ROE this week. Fifty educators and social workers from Jamaica and the ROE #11 area are attending.

Bibby Appleby moved to adjourn the meeting. Kay Kearney seconded. Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:02 p.m.
